SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of the University of Namibia

The University of Namibia reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per site, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process; and
- (c) reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the services mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing, and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable.
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV.
- (c) the Specifications and Performance Standards in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Contract Data Sheet in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should submit the following documents. All copies must be duly certified by the Namibian Police.

- (a) have a valid company Registration Certificate;
- (b) have an original or certified valid good standing Tax Certificate
- (c) have an original or certified valid good standing Social Security Certificate (the certificate should be issued no longer than 30 calendar days from the closing date of this bidding process);
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (f) have a certified copy of certificate indicating SME Status (for bids reserved for SME's).
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-

clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof.

- (h) Have either two or more relevant, contactable, and **certified reference letters** from a reputable organization for similar goods supplied within the last five years (5). The letter must be on the client's letterhead, clearly stating the item(s) delivered, and must be signed and stamped by the client.
- (i) Preference will be given to a supplier with sufficient knowledge about the instrument to be supplied. The supplier who demonstrates ability to provide further technical support including installation and training would also be preferred. Suppliers should demonstrate that the instrument is supplied with basic reagents and ready to be used without purchasing additional reagents or consumables.

Where the supplier is merely an agent (and not the manufacturer), the supplier should provide proof that they will be able to provide further technical support by availing a technician or technical person to install and train University staff members who will use the instrument supplied. Such proof could be a letter from the manufacturer or main supplier of the instrument stating that a trainer or technical person will be availed to provide technical support after the instrument is purchased. The cost of providing this technical assistance shall not be covered by the University.

Support to suppliers

The University shall provide support such as laboratory space for installation and training.

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

6. Delivery

Delivery shall be **30** days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

The following inspection will be done upon delivery:

- if the material is brand new
- If the material meets the requested specifications

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the **University of Namibia** with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Bid Box located at **The University of Namibia Main Campus, Ground Floor, Administration Building, Mandume Ndemufayo Street, Pionierspark**. not later than **08 May 2024 – 12h00.** Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach same address by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the University of Namibia immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the University of Namibia and available to any bidder on request within three (3) working days.

10. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotation's documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to **University of Namibia** requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

11. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.

12. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

13. Notification of Award and Debriefing

The University of Namibia shall after the award of contract promptly inform all unsuccessful bidders in writing of the name and address of the successful bidder and the contract amount and post a notice of award on its website within seven (7) days. Furthermore, the **University of Namibia** shall attend to all requests for debriefing made in writing within seven (7) days of the unsuccessful bidders being informed of the award.
